Legacy Park Riders Association & Riding Opportunities

2022 was the start of a new association for great riding folks; small groups of riding buddies that need to be covered by insurance to participate in drill competitions, parades and produce small events.

Cowboy Campground at Legacy Park, just outside of Idaho City, has easy access off Highway 21 and is growing, with a great idea from board member Kim Hartmann and Sabrina Amidon started to build on Kim's idea.

The original idea was to start a riding group, called Legacy Park Riders Association, the name ties in with our name, Legacy Park Trust, a 501c3 nonprofit. Legacy Park Trust was created to raise the funds to purchase the 15 acre property, preserving it from future development. It will be put into a land conservation, protecting it, keeping it open for families to enjoy forever. Members see the need to grow our riders group and assist with a few annual functions.

Why do we need another group?

We are creating a blanket organization that will welcome smaller, nonprofit groups, that might otherwise will not be able to grow, compete, show or participate in parades and expos. We have an arena, 2 round pens that are usually sitting empty during the week and lots of weekends, it's high time to see them filled and actively used.

Did you know that Idaho City has a very nice Rodeo Arena, conveniently neighboring Cowboy Campground that can be rented for less than \$200 per day? The city does need an insurance writer, otherwise is cannot be rented. Our Association has the insurance to cover events to help grow events in Idaho City.

The Treasure Valley is outgrowing their competitive arenas, and Idaho City is well positioned at just an hour, scenic, drive away. Enjoy trail riding without the need to drive dusty, ruddy forest roads hours away from Boise. We have a closer place to recreate and ride or use as a hub to get to additional areas.

Our annual special event hosted, every 2nd weekend in June, is the St Jude's Fun Ride. Other events will be Trail challenges and Ride Retreats for young and old currently in September we are hosting the Pony Express Challenge. We encourage members to donate time to help with events and some fundraising for Legacy Park to make it an even better place to enjoy.

What does it take to join?

Regular Membership: \$100 annual fee or \$150 per family. Added Benefits: •2 Nights Free horse site per annum, that can also be gifted to friends (\$55 value) •Free Day Rides (\$10 value) •Discounted entry fees to Legacy Park Events or sponsored clinics

•Free Day Rides for 2 trailers (\$20 value per day)

•Discounted entry fees to Legacy Park Events or sponsored clinics

You don't ride, but want to be a member, you can join as an affiliate or non rider supporter for this nonprofit.

The funds received will cover insurance, wear and tear of roads/arenas/equipment/outhouses etc.

Reservations are needed, since we are getting busier and we wouldn't want anyone to miss out.

Can my small breakout group membership allow us to do shows/events at other places than Cowboy Campground at Legacy Park?

Of course, our association is not grounded in Idaho City and it wouldn't be a fair to create a great group without allowing members to spread their wings, while also spreading the word about our great association.

Now is the time to jump in and help complete the foundation, being a cornerstone, and a founding team member! Let's make this a great, forward-thinking association that is welcoming to all disciplines and skills. Not only an adult association but we would like to welcome a youth charter to be organized under our association.

Annual events are scavenger, poker rides, riding challenges, working equitation and more to keep this group fun and interactive. These events and many other activities would not be made possible without hard work and participation of our members, which are the foundation of any club. Legacy Park Riders Association extends an invitation to other private groups and community organizations to enjoy the use of our facilities, and to reserve/rent Cowboy Campground @ Legacy Park for private events and programs.
